SENATE BILL NO. 2306

- AN ACT TO PROHIBIT THE ESTABLISHMENT OF SANCTUARY CITIES; TO
 AUTHORIZE ALL MISSISSIPPI LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS TO ASSIST
 FEDERAL AGENCIES BY LEGALLY DETAINING ILLEGAL ALIENS; TO INDEMNIFY
 LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS FOR IMPLEMENTATION OF THIS ACT; AND FOR
 RELATED PURPOSES.
- 6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI:
- 7 **SECTION 1.** (1) No official or governing authority of a
- 8 municipality of this state may limit or restrict the enforcement
- 9 of federal immigration laws to less than the full extent permitted
- 10 by federal law.
- 11 (2) A state, county or municipal law enforcement agency
- 12 shall notify federal immigration authorities of the incarceration
- 13 of a person who is not legally present in the United States and
- 14 shall fully honor any detainer placed by federal immigration
- 15 authorities upon a person who is not legally present in the United
- 16 States.
- 17 (3) This section shall be implemented in a manner consistent
- 18 with federal laws regulating immigration, protecting the civil

- 19 rights of all persons and respecting the privileges and immunities
- 20 of United States citizens.
- 21 **SECTION 2.** (1) All law enforcement officers of this state
- 22 are authorized to assist federal agencies in the enforcement of
- 23 federal immigration law.
- 24 (2) If an alien who is unlawfully present in the United
- 25 States is convicted of a violation of state or local law, on
- 26 discharge from imprisonment or on the assessment of any monetary
- 27 obligation that is imposed, the United States Immigration and
- 28 Customs Enforcement or the United States Customs and Border
- 29 Protection shall be notified immediately.
- 30 (3) Notwithstanding any other law, a law enforcement agency
- 31 may securely transport to a federal facility in this state or to
- 32 any other point of transfer into federal custody that is outside
- 33 the jurisdiction of the law enforcement agency an alien for whom
- 34 the agency has received verification that the alien is unlawfully
- 35 present in the United States and is in the agency's custody.
- 36 (4) A law enforcement officer shall not be liable in any
- 37 civil action for an arrest based on probable cause and in good
- 38 faith under this section, or failure, in good faith, to make an
- 39 arrest under the authority this section. A law enforcement
- 40 officer is indemnified by the law enforcement officer's agency
- 41 against reasonable costs and expenses, including attorney's fees,
- 42 incurred by the officer in connection with any action, suit or
- 43 proceeding brought pursuant to this section in which the officer

- 44 may be a defendant by reason of the officer being or having been a
- 45 member of the law enforcement agency.
- 46 **SECTION 3.** This act shall take effect and be in force from
- 47 and after July 1, 2016.
