1 2 3 4	A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION RECOGNIZING THE SPECIAL ECONOMIC AND HISTORICAL FRIENDSHIP BETWEEN THE STATE OF MISSISSIPPI AND ISRAEL ON THE OCCASION OF THE 60TH ANNIVERSARY OF THE ESTABLISHMENT OF THE MODERN STATE OF ISRAEL AND TO ENCOURAGE TRADE.
5	WHEREAS, many communities along the Mississippi River were
6	settled by Jewish immigrants from Europe who had entered the
7	United States through the Port of New Orleans. These families
8	were leading members of the business communities of these river
9	cities, made considerable civic and charitable contributions and
10	became part of the fabric of these important economic centers; and
11	WHEREAS, there is a special bond of friendship between the
12	citizens of Mississippi and Israel that inspires the people of
13	Mississippi to stand with the people of Israel in solidarity and
14	welcome all opportunities to grow our already deep relationship at
15	all levels, including cultural, academic and business endeavors;
16	and
17	WHEREAS, on May 14, 1948, the 5th day of Iyar, Jewish
18	representatives from all over Palestine met in the Tel Aviv Museum
19	where David Ben-Gurion declared Israel's independence, and in the
20	following 4 months, some 50,000 newcomers, mainly Holocaust
21	survivors, reached Israel's shores; and
22	WHEREAS, May 2008 marks the 60th anniversary of the modern
23	State of Israel; and
24	WHEREAS, during those 60 years, Israel has stood as the only
25	beacon of democracy and freedom in the region and has always been

WHEREAS, Israel is a top export destination from Mississippi.

a true friend to the people of Mississippi; and

- 29 increase projected in 2008). Israel is one of Mississippi's top
- 30 50 trading partners (ranked 47th). Top exports include aircraft,
- 31 spacecraft equipment and commodities; and
- 32 WHEREAS, Israel's humanitarian aid to Mississippi after
- 33 Hurricane Katrina was considerable: Israel sent humanitarian aid
- 34 to the Mississippi Gulf Coast, airlifting over 80 tons of
- 35 supplies; Israel dispatched field hospitals, hundreds of doctors
- 36 and nurses to the Gulf Coast; Magen David Adom (Israel's official
- 37 part of the Red Cross) established "United Brotherhood Operation,"
- 38 sending additional supplies and services to the region; and Israel
- 39 also invited displaced university students to attend Israeli
- 40 universities; and
- WHEREAS, Mississippi is proud to be the home of Israeli
- 42 companies which provide protection for U.S. troops in Iraq. For
- 43 example, STARK Aerospace builds UAVs for U.S. forces, with offices
- 44 and production in Columbus and Starkville, Mississippi. It is a
- 45 subsidiary of Israel Aerospace Industries, Ltd., which makes
- 46 Hunter UAV models with 20,000+ operation hours in Iraq and
- 47 Afghanistan; and
- WHEREAS, Mississippi defends Israeli citizens from missile
- 49 attacks through the Arrow Interceptor missile which is made in
- 50 Mississippi; and
- 51 WHEREAS, Ingalls Shipyard builds ships for the Israeli Navy
- 52 (including SA'AR 5 Class corvettes) and Israeli ships are used to
- 53 protect shores from terrorist weapons smuggling and maritime
- 54 terrorist attacks. The USS Cole's mission is an example of
- 55 Mississippi supporting Israeli defense; and
- 56 WHEREAS, the Mississippi Commission on the Holocaust works to
- 57 draw lessons from the history of the Holocaust in order to help
- 18 lead new generations of Mississippians beyond racism and bigotry:
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE STATE OF
- 60 MISSISSIPPI, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING THEREIN, That
- 61 we do hereby recognize the special historical and economic

- 62 friendship between Mississippi and Israel and express our
- 63 appreciation to his Excellency Ambassador Mansour for his tireless
- 64 efforts to promote peace and grow the business, cultural and
- 65 educational ties between our two nations.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the members of this Legislature
- 67 extend congratulations to the people of Israel on the occasion of
- 68 the 60th anniversary of the modern State of Israel and reaffirm
- 69 their strong support of the Israeli people and the God-given right
- 70 of the State of Israel to exist and offer their full support and
- 71 prayers.
- 72 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That this body hereby encourages
- 73 further cultural, educational and business exchanges between the
- 74 citizens of Mississippi and Israel and welcomes all opportunities
- 75 to develop the special bond of friendship and trade between
- 76 Mississippi and Israel.
- 77 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Secretary of the Senate is
- 78 authorized and directed to transmit an appropriate copy of this
- 79 resolution to his Excellency Ambassador Mansour and that copies be
- 80 forwarded to the Mississippi Development Authority, and be made
- 81 available to the Capitol Press Corps.
